Elementary: 10:30 am Judea Reform

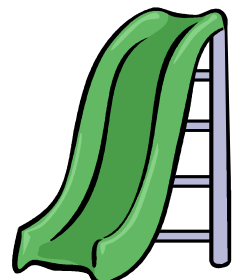

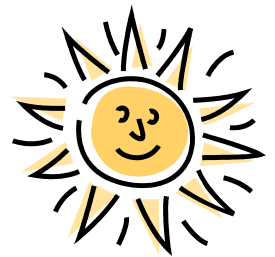

## **Pillowcase Washing Directions**

*Below are washing instructions for the pillowcases used for Tikun Leil Shavuot.*

If painted, iron with clean rag between iron and case for 30 seconds, then wash separately in cold water. If crayon designed, wash with cold water but **do not put in dryer!** Hang to dry.
